3. Key Responsibilities

- **3.1** Carry out drainage system maintenance works.
- 3.2 Assist the team leader to conduct and record inspections and works details of Councils drainage systems in accordance with service agreements.
- **3.3** Drive and operate drainage maintenance related plant and equipment.
- 3.4 Work cooperatively with other Drainage Crew team members to achieve work requirements.
- 3.5 Maintain accurate diary records and time sheet records ensuring that all labour and plant hours are recorded.
- 3.6 Provide on the job instruction to employees new to the area of responsibility and attend training sessions as necessary to fulfil employment responsibilities.
- **3.7** Advise the team leader of strategies that could be implemented to improve service delivery by the drainage team.
- **3.8** Support the Works & Operations Unit by providing appropriate traffic control measures at worksites and assist other work teams as requested.

4. Core Physical Requirements

- **4.1** Capacity to work in an outdoor environment in all weather conditions.
- **4.2** Capacity to, on occasion, lift items unspecified in weight within individual limits.
- **4.3** Capacity to perform heavy manual duties.
- **4.4** Capacity to bend knees or squat to ground level on occasional basis.
- **4.5** Capacity to walk on / negotiate uneven and hard surfaces or sloping ground.
- **4.6** Capacity to walk distances greater than 1 kilometre.
- **4.7** Capacity to step up and down from plant & equipment frequently.
- **4.8** Capacity to drive a motor vehicle.

5. Accountability and Extent of Authority

- **5.1** Accountable for the effective and efficient undertaking of drainage system maintenance works, including open drains, construction works, culverts and pit and pipe inspections.
- **5.2** Accountable for assisting the team leader to conduct and record inspections of Council's drainage systems.
- **5.3** Authorised to make on the job decisions affecting work performance, materials, conditions and health and safety.
- **5.4** Authorised to take appropriate action to ensure own and public safety.

6. Judgement and Decision Making

- **6.1** The tasks to be performed will involve selection from a range of techniques, systems, equipment, methods or processes.
- **6.2** Problem solving will require some originality in approach with solutions usually based on previously encountered procedures and practices.

7. Knowledge and Skills

- 7.1 Specialist Skills and Knowledge
 - **7.1.1** Ability to provide guidance and assistance as part of the work team in carrying out maintenance of Council's drainage systems.
 - **7.1.2** The ability to drive and operate drainage maintenance related plant and equipment.
 - **7.1.3** Well developed observation skills.
 - 7.1.4 Ability to safely sign work sites in accordance with the Traffic Management Code of Practice.
- 7.2 Management Skills
 - **7.2.1** Ability to work in a team environment or alone with minimal supervision.

- **7.2.2** The ability to reach objectives within a timeframe.
- **7.2.3** Ability to effectively and efficiently utilise resources.
- **7.2.4** Ability to supervise new team members and other staff or casuals assisting the team and provide on-the-job training and guidance.
- 7.3 Interpersonal Skills
 - **7.3.1** Ability to follow and understand verbal and written instructions.
- **7.3.2** Ability to communicate effectively and gain cooperation and assistance from employees and the general public.
- **7.3.3** Ability to work cooperatively with team members and other Council staff.
- **7.3.4** Ability and commitment to follow safe work practices and procedures.
